Only committee chairs that have pertinent information will be called on to report at any cabinet meeting. All reports should be kept to a maximum of 3 minutes. The Cabinet Tail twister will be active, and if any member exceeds the allotted time, a fine could be imposed.

All Region, Zone, and Committee Chairs will turn in a written report to the Secretary and the District Governor at each meeting. If you are unable to attend a meeting - please mail or e- mail your report to the Secretary and the District Governor.
