Attention Lions!!

As the 18th annual District M2 Convention approaches, now is the time to make your plans to be there and participate in the weekend events.

The Convention will be March 27th – 29th, 2026.

The entire Convention will be held at the DoubleTree Hotel St. Louis at Westport. The Friday night Hospitality will be held in the Grand Ballroom. We are planning on being able to accommodate as many hospitality booths in one large area as we have in past years, including entertainment and a dance floor.

We will be assigning the booths based on the postmark date and if we need to reduce the number of booths, we will accept the earliest registrations; **SO REGISTER EARLY.**

Hospitality will be free to all fully registered Convention attendees, who will be given an arm band to wear that evening. Non-registered guests/Lions will be charged a small entrance fee of \$3.00 to receive an arm band, or two arm bands for \$5.00.

The cost of a hospitality booth this year will stay the same as last year at \$190.00. This will include hospitality booth/tables (approx. 16' x 8' made with three 8-foot tables, tablecloths, trash service and chairs. In addition, your booth will receive 5

additional arm bands, FREE! Please bring your own 'startup ice' when you set up your booth. It will make it easier for us and the hotel and your Club(s). You will be able to refresh your ice during the evening as needed from the hotel cooler outside.

This year we are allowing Clubs to share a single booth for the \$190 cost, if they would like. We believe this will allow more fellowship and sharing and not make the Hospitality event too much work for just few Lions in a single Club.

Please submit your reservations and special request as soon as possible. Please make your payments payable to: District 26-M2 Convention Fund and mailed to PDG Devin Struttmann, 770 Oakmont Lane, Union, MO 63084 devin@admr.com. The Convention Committee will then assign all hospitality spaces.

As in the past, we strongly encourage the Clubs that are participating to provide food and beverages to share. To help offset the expense of this event, you will be allowed to conduct a fundraiser in your booth if you desire.
